# 22/159 Matters raised by the Chairman

The Chairman referred to the meeting by himself and the clerk with Devon Highways, attended by the highways engineer and highways officer. The list of issues discussed was,

- Repositioning of weight restriction sign; outcome will be done at Parish expense.
- Collapsed drains in Kenn & kennford; DCC drawing up a plan to replace, subject to budget allowance.
- Damage to drains at the triangle in Kenn; A kerb could be put in, but at the parish councils' expense, including material cost, labour, insurance cover.
- Blocked surface water channels in Clapham; DCC agreed to clear the channels of accumulation of earth and Debry to ensure surface water reached the drains.
- Litter on road approach to Kenbury recycling depot; Parish council to liaise with Kenbury to enforce the the condition of cover being on all skips arriving and departing the site.
- Rubbish on A379, DCC to liaise with TDC to combine activities to allow litter to be cleared at the same time as road repairs to ensure minimum road closure.
- To check on damage to retaining wall outside Brook cottage Kenn; DCC monitoring and will commence repairs when it is deemed necessary.

Action Clerk to monitor progress liaise with Kenbury Recycling.
