23/207 Matters raised by the Chairman

The chairman noted that following the councils persistent reporting of the defective Junction repairs at the school entrance, that finally a substantial repair had been conducted by DCC contractors. There is a question of better communication with Devon highways to stop duplication of repairs if the parish Lengths man conducts repairs that may have been reported to Highways by a member of the public.

The parish lengths man has conducted gully clearing work and cutting back of

overgrowth in various areas of the village.

The new school under construction on the South West Exeter development (Matford Brook academy) Due to open in September 23, Is delayed due to serious structural issues.
